The tune is Serbian but from South Hungary. There are many minority villages of Serbs and Croats living in South Hungary. The title means "If sour cherries were like sweet ones". This is a love song, where the singer sings about her youthful beauty passing while waiting too long for her sweetheart to come to her.


Formation: open circle in a V hold to start, meandering line to greet.

N.B. you can also leave out the arm movements and then do in a W hold throughout.

Metre: 3/4 counted slowly 1 & 2 & 3.

Style: small light steps

Introduction: 10 bars - start with the singing.
