MUSIC: Christopher Tin on the CD Calling all Dawns available on iTunes. Baba Yetu means 'Our

Father' and is sung in Swahili

FORMATION: Circle in a V hold

RHYTHM: 4/4

INTRODUCTION: 4 bars of solo vocals. Come in with the choir

Each step has an equal beat

- 1. Un-joined, slowly raising the arms, take four steps into the centre on a curve starting on the R foot (last time dance ends here bringing hands down to the heart)
- 2. Bringing hands down in front of face to your heart take 4 steps straight back out to the line of dance starting on the R foot
- 3. Joined in V hold grapevine to the right starting with a side step on the R, then L across in front, side R and L across behind
- 4. Take a side step on the R foot and touch with the L. Mirror this with a side step on the L foot and touch with the R
